

AccuRIP is a Network RIP

Follow these instructions when you wish to share the AccuRIP driver (built for your selected Epson model) with other users on your Network. Install on just one host computer and share it. Easy!

PC to Mac Sharing...

When AccuRIP is hosted by a PC and you wish to print from a Mac on the same network you'll need to manually add the proper printer ppd file to the Mac system.

PC

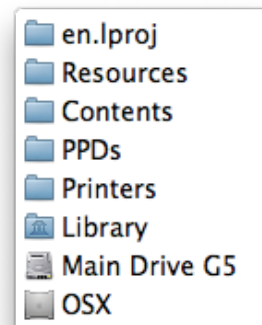
1. On the PC (depending on your OS) either Right Click the "AccuRIP to Epson driver" in the control panel/Printers and choose "Sharing" or Right Click on Printer Properties and choose Sharing. Keep the stock labeling of "AccuRIPt" or give the shared driver a custom name such as (AccuRIP1400) for an Epson 1400.

MAC

2. You will need the "Mac PPD files" for your printer model. They can be downloaded from the Rapid Response System <http://www.softwareforscreenprintertech.com/images/stories/downloads>

3. You must have admin rights and permissions for this step. "Drag and drop" or "copy and paste" the PPD file into the System print folder "en.lproj".

Follow this path: Your Main Hard Drive/Library/Printers/PPDs/Contents/Resources/en.lproj



4. Restart the Mac.

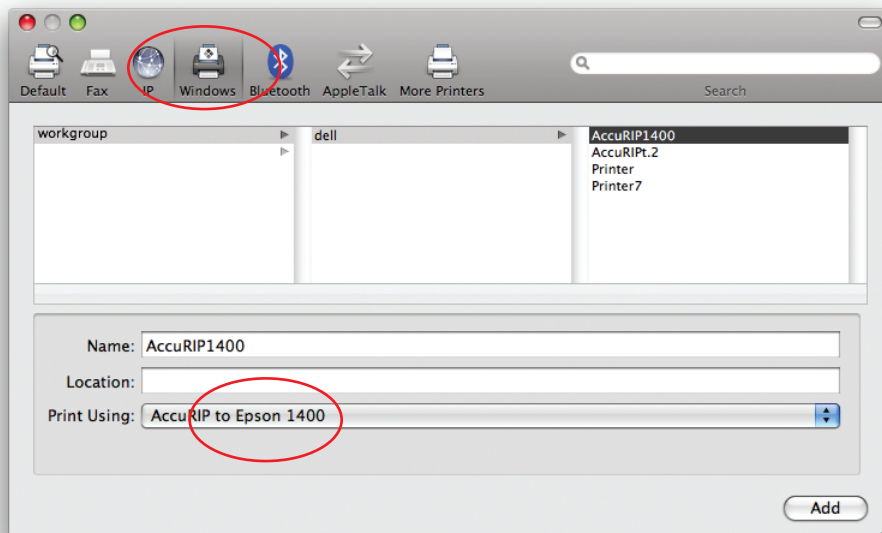
5. From the System Preferences, open Print&Fax

6. Click the Add Printer icon (+)

7. From the list of "Windows printers" locate the shared AccuRIP print driver. Choose the proper workgroup and computer to display shared printers.

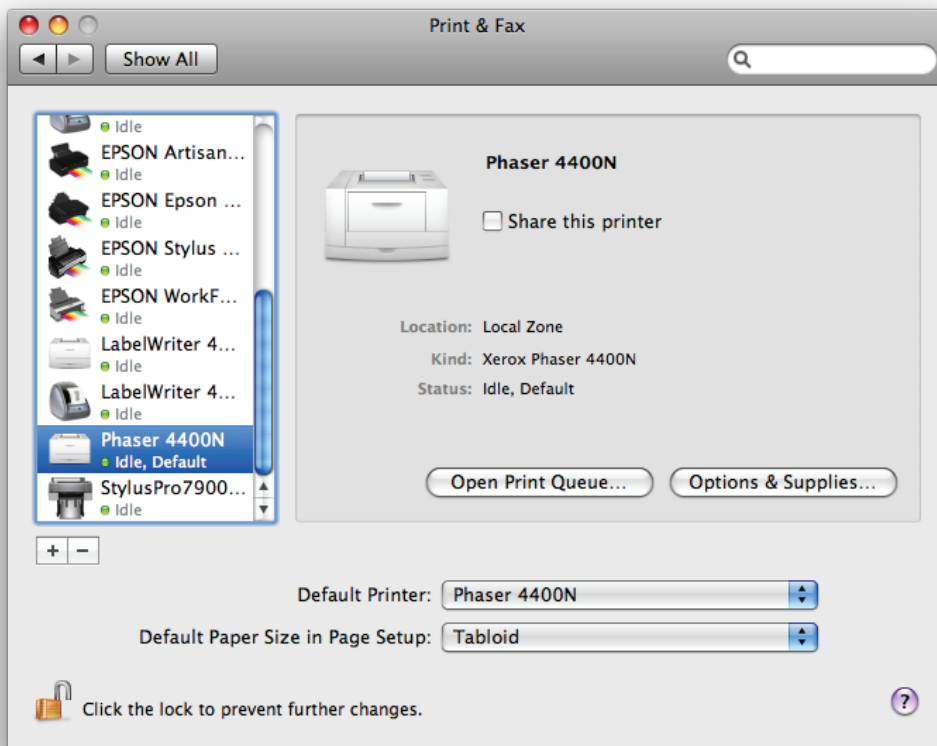
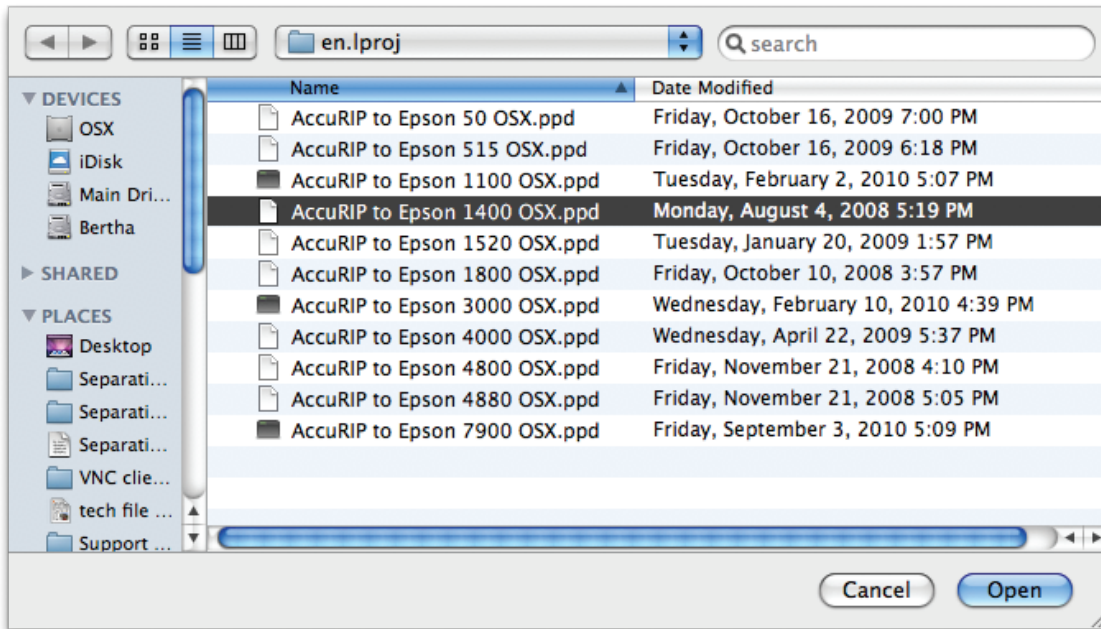
8. From the "Print Using" Pop-down menu: If the PPD file is not automatically selected, click "other..." and navigate to the AccuRIP PPD file previously installed into your system (step 3), then click OPEN and then ADD.

PC to Mac

AccuRIP is now available as a printer selection in the print window of all your programs.



NOTE: AccuRIP Software is designed to work with (1) Epson model at a time and shared with any or all users across your Local Area Network. If you wish to use AccuRIP for additional Epson models simultaneously contact Freehand or your Reseller to purchase an additional User License (another copy of AccuRIP).
